planetary home? The moral challenge is heightened by matters of climate justice: those most vulnerable to the ravages of climate change are also the people least responsible for it. In this context, Earth’s religious traditions are called to plumb their depths, seeking wellsprings of moral vision, hope, and wisdom for building ecologically sound and socially just ways of living. Christian traditions are rich with such resources. One is the call to love

neighbor as self, understood as not only an interpersonal vocation but also an ecological-economic vocation. Another is the call to heed God’s presence ‘flowing and pouring through all things.’” *Cynthia Moe-Lobeda*
